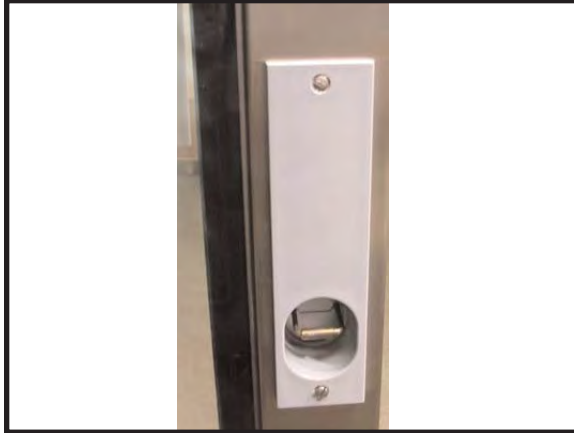


## Removing and Repairing the Door Lock Mechanism on the SmartCombi

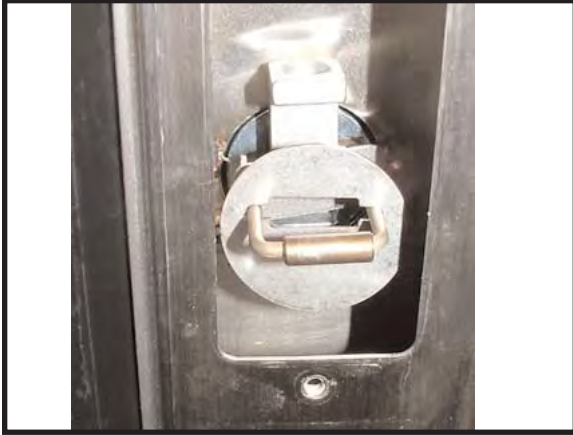


Remove the plastic cover from the locking mechanism

## Removing and Repairing the Door Lock Mechanism on the SmartCombi



Carefully remove the metal cover disc



Now carefully remove the metal spacer

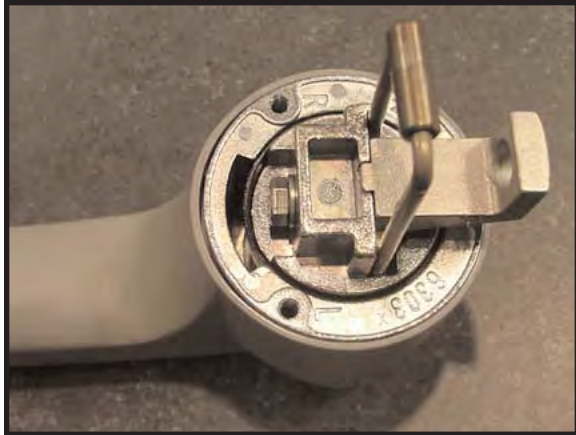


Notice that there are three screws. Remove the three screws using a T-15 torx driver.

It is easiest to remove the top screw first by rotating the handle to expose the screw head.

Be careful. . . if they drop it can be difficult to retrieve them

## Removing and Repairing the Door Lock Mechanism on the SmartCombi



The door handle and mechanism can now be removed from the door.



To remove the mechanism first remove the decal. save this for later.

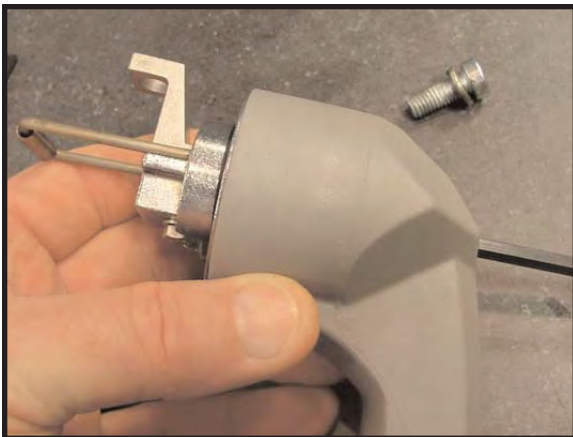


Note the 5mm Allen screw behind the decal.

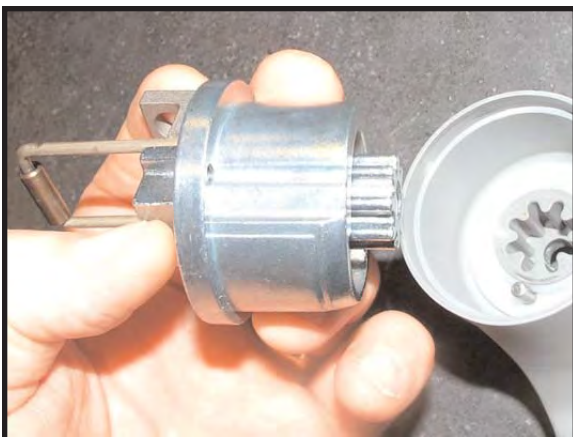
## Removing and Repairing the Door Lock Mechanism on the SmartCombi



Remove the 5mm Allen screw

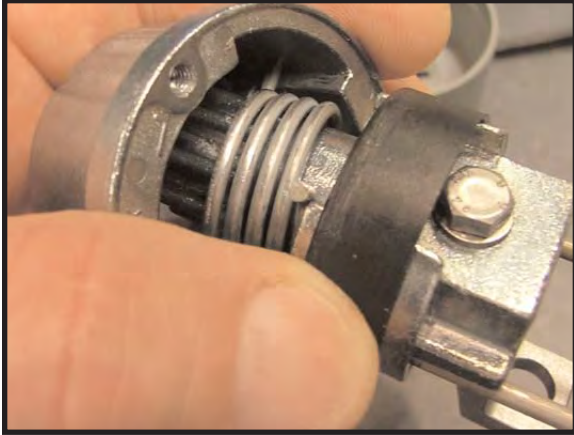


Using the Allen wrench, push out the mechanism.



You should now have the mechanism in your hands

## Removing and Repairing the Door Lock Mechanism on the SmartCombi



Carefully pull the mechanism apart. There is a spring inside so use caution



All of the door handle parts - this comes as one assembly (MM207092)



## Removing and Repairing the Door Lock Mechanism on the SmartCombi



Place the black plastic piece onto the "hook"  
piece.



It will fit only in one position

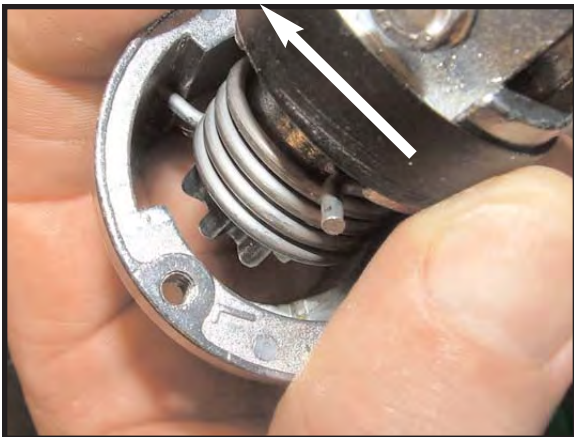


Now place the spring onto this as shown

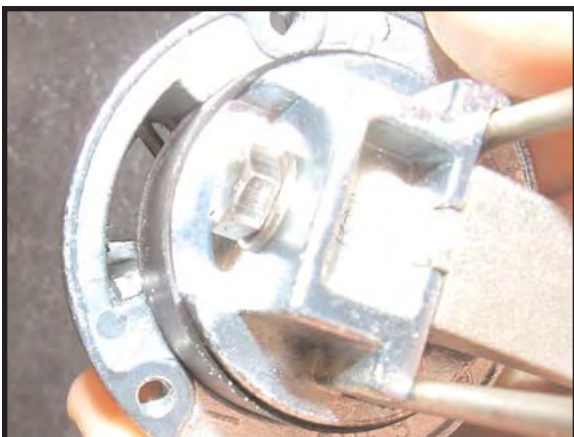
## Removing and Repairing the Door Lock Mechanism on the SmartCombi



Insert the assembly into the housing. Be sure that the spring lines up with the notch in the housing



Carefully rotate the assembly clockwise until the other "pin of the spring lines up with the other notch in the housing.

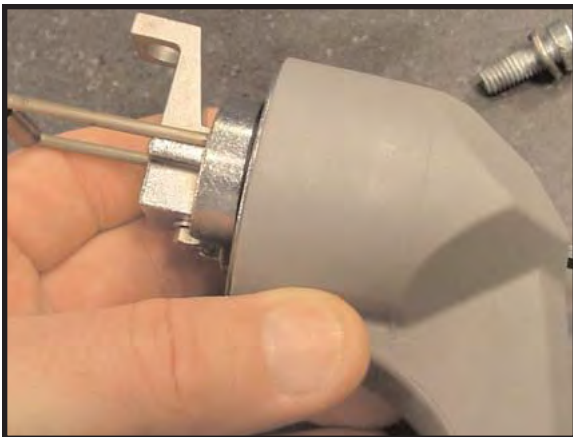


Slide the assembly into the housing

## Removing and Repairing the Door Lock Mechanism on the SmartCombi



Now place the complete assembly into the  
the handle.



Reinstall the screw



## Removing and Repairing the Door Lock Mechanism on the SmartCombi



Place the handle onto the door and install the bottom two screws first and the top screw last.

Again be careful not to drop the screws. Putty, gum, or some other sticky substance will help you.



Install the metal spacer

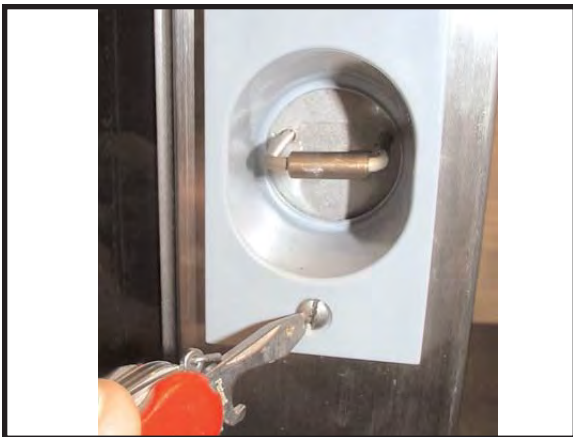


Install the cover disc
